The Parksville Volunteer Fire Department 2018 food and toy drive was once again a tremendous success due to the generosity of residents throughout the Parksville Fire Protection Area. In the two days of the annual drive, the department collected 26,720 pounds of food and \$27,217.30 in cash. The Parksville Volunteer Fire Department has been conducting the food drive since 1998.

Firefighters, honorary members and volunteers went door to door to collect for the Salvation Army food bank. This year, the single largest donation was made by the Craig Bay Resident Association which contributed 2,600 pounds of food and \$15,000 in cash donations.
